**COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS  
February 24<sup>th</sup>, 2020**

The City Council of the City of Flandreau, South Dakota, met in special session on Monday, February 24<sup>th</sup>, 2020 at 6:30 p.m. at the City Council Chambers, 1005 W. Elm Avenue, Flandreau, SD.

Present: Aldermen: Brad Bjerke, Bob Pesall, Dan Sutton, Karen Tufty, Jason Unger, and Donald Whitman. Absent: Mayor Mark Bonrud. Also present were City Administrator Jeff Pederson; Finance Officer Karen Gundvaldson; and Brenda Wade Schmidt, Moody County Enterprise.

The proposed agenda was reviewed. Motion by Whitman and seconded by Tufty to adopt the proposed agenda. The following members voted aye: Bjerke, Pesall, Sutton, Tufty, Unger, and Whitman. Nays: None. Absent: None. Motion carried.

City Administrator Pederson presented information regarding prospective capital improvement projects for the City that ranged from conceptual design to more detailed. Items presented included: Downtown 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue Face Lift; Airport Runway Reconstruction or Replacement; Golf Course Flood Damage and Flood Mitigation Measures; Conversion of the Crescent Street Bridge to a Pedestrian Bridge; Flandreau Dam Mitigation; Tennis Court Parking Lot; Installation of a Dog Park and a Skate Park on the Duncan Park Property; Community Center/Armory HVAC System; Bates Street Improvements; New Fire Station; City Office Exterior Improvements; and Video Equipment and internet streaming of City Council Meetings. Photos, drawings, and maps as well as cost estimates of several of the projects were presented. Pederson also presented information regarding current funds available for project funding, as well as information related to the sale of General Obligation Bonds.

Council members were asked to review the information in preparation for subsequent decisions regarding project priorities and timetables.

The Council President declared the meeting adjourned at 8:13 p.m.
